

Hey! Print this off and cut it out. Fold it, and stuff it in your wallet, If an injury occurs that you may need medical attention and reimbursement from your SAIP insurance, or the incident may have legal implications, you've got a quick reference guide to know what to do!

SAIP INJURY PROCEDURE

1. Notify SAIP and Canada Snowboard You May be Submitting a Claim. Contact info on Reverse Side.
2. File SAIP Reimbursement Claim Form Within 30 Days of Injury
3. Note: If hospitalization is needed and/or Circumstances Arise That May Have Liability Implications, Fill in the Incident Reporting Form on C-S Website and Submit to the Three Indicated Organizations Listed on the Form
4. International Incident: If an injury occurs outside of Canada, Contact the Insurance Provider Prior to Receiving Major Medical Attention Immediately-Contact info on reverse side
