2.2 Athlete Eligibility

Athletes must:

- Hold a valid WPAS Licence for 2020/2021 season and have achieved race points in one race of the 2019/2020 or 2020/2021 season.
- Be at least sixteen (16) years old by 31 December 2020.
- Be internationally classified with either a '**Confirmed**' sport class status or a '**Review 2021**' sport class status or later.
- *Note: If an athlete meets all other criteria but fails to earn WPAS points due to medical or other extraordinary circumstances a bipartite request can be submitted by the NPC to the WPAS (info@WorldParaAlpineSkiing.org) for review. Not all requests are guaranteed to be approved and further documentation might be requested by WPAS.*

For technical events:

Slalom

- Be ranked and have for the Men 240 WPAS points or less and for the Women 280 WPAS points or less on the WPAS Slalom Ranking List as of **25 January 2021**.

- Be ranked and have for the Men 240 WPAS points or less and for the Women 280 WPAS points or less on the WPAS Giant Slalom Ranking List as of **25 January 2021**.

3.2 Athlete Eligibility

Athletes must:

- Hold a valid WPNS Licence for the 2020/2021 season
- Have earned WPNS points in 2019/2020 and/or 2020/2021 season.
Note: If the athlete meets all other criteria but fails to earn WPNS points due to medical or other extraordinary circumstances a bipartite request can be submitted by the NPC to the WPNS STC for review. Not all requests are guaranteed to be approved.
- Be at least fifteen (15) years old by 7 February 2021
- Be internationally classified with either a '**Confirmed**' sport class status or a '**Review 2021**' or later sport class status.

4.2 Athlete Eligibility

Athletes must:

- Hold a valid WPSB Licence for the 2020/2021 season and have achieved race points in one race of the 2019/2020 or 2020/2021 season.
- Minimum age: Athlete must have year of birth **2006**.
- Be internationally classified with either a '**Confirmed**' sport class status or a '**Review 2021**' sport class status or later.
- *Note: Nations may apply for bipartite slots and must send an application e-mail, discipline specific, at least two weeks before the first training day of the event in question to the World Para Snowboard (info@WorldParaSnowboard.org & racedirector@worldparasnowboard.org. World Para Snowboard is entitled to ask for additional information regarding the application.*

For **Snowboard Cross and Team** event:

- Be ranked and have for the Men 100 WPSB points or more and for the Women 100 WPSB points or more on the WPSB Snowboard Cross Ranking List as of **29 January 2021**.

For **Dual Banked Slalom** event:

- Be ranked and have for the Men 50 WPSB points or more and for the Women 50 WPSB points or more on the WPSB Snowboard Cross or Banked Slalom Ranking List as of **29 January 2021**.
