Eligibility - JR NON-FIS Competition Competitors aged 12 years old and younger as of December 31st, 2023.

International Athletes Notice

To confirm you are eligible to compete, the Event Organizers MUST receive OFFICIAL FIS ENTRY from your National Snowboard Association prior to your arrival at the event. NSO's to submit by email to: sian@ontariosnowboard.ca
